



Coroner: She was killed over and over and over

STOCKTON — The focus on two men accused of killing a Tracy woman in August shifted today from their status as a gay married couple to the bloody murder scene they're charged with leaving behind.

Robert and Jorge Morgan stand accused of killing Cynthia Ramos, 58, on Aug. 6 inside her trailer at Green Oaks Mobile Home Park. San Joaquin County's Medical Examiner gave shocking testimony in court of Ramos' violent death.

"She was killed over and over and over," Bennett Omalu said, explaining that Ramos appeared to have fought back as she was stabbed 55 times, struck 13 times with something hard and strangled with twine or a small rope.

Testimony is set to end Friday when Garber could announce whether the Morgans will stand trial on murder and robbery charges that make them eligible to spend the rest of their natural lives in state prison.
