

Two Tracy men plead guilty to stabbing their neighbor 50 times

STOCKTON, CA - Two Tracy men plead guilty to the murder of their neighbor in a surprise development Tuesday.

Robert Morgan, 39, and his domestic partner, 24-year-old Jorge Morgan, have taken responsibility for the brutal stabbing death of 58-year-old Cynthia Ramos. The victim had more than 50 stab wounds.

"They don't deserve to ever walk the streets again," said Ramos' son Daniel Martinez.

The Morgans were expected to go to trial, but agreed to the plea deal instead. Their sentence will be life in prison without the possibility of parole.

Family and friends of Ramos watched the sentencing with some relief.

"As far as the pain, it goes so deep on so many levels, never knew my heart until it was broke," said Martinez.

"Nothing will make sense. I can't understand their mentality. It's not human," said Ramos' daughter Christina Barnes.

The Morgans also plead guilty to robbery after taking the victims jewelry.
